The community united all 4 estates rather than dividing them. Hastings Hill, Grindon, Springwell, and Thorney Close have good walking, cycling, and public transport links using the buses 16, 18, and 23. We are all served by the same community groups, churches, and youth activities provided by Grindon Young Peoples Centre, also the the Air Cadets on Tay Road. Hastings Hill, Grindon, Springwell, Thorney Close share a secondary School, in Sandhill View and also 3 infant schools. They all share medical facilities with Springwell Health Centre, and Grindon Primary Care Centre. Chester Road A183 is a very busy carriage way which provides a hard boundary between Hastings hill, Grindon areas and Pennywell and South Hylton to the North.
