More and more, particularly with the newly established Co-op, the Penshaw community is moving away from Shiney Row as its “centre”. Activity focuses around the Whitefield playing fields, the row of shops and takeaways to its East, and the previously mentioned Co-op, creating a feeling of its own community, distant from the shops and Facilities just off of Shiney Row roundabout.
