I oppose the changes proposed, to make Trinity ward part of Bisley, Cranham and Painswick. Stroud is a town, and Trinity is part of Stroud. It's urban, not rural, and many facilities located within Trinity ward, such as Stroud hospital, Trinity church and the Trinity rooms belong to Stroud. Realigning the boundaries makes no sense administratively for the town council, nor the district council. Any councillor appointed to represent such disparate areas such as Bisley, Cranham, Painswick and Trinity will struggle to attend all meetings and have an in depth knowledge of all the school, parishes and local issues.

If the numbers need to be adjusted, please consider including a different village within the rural cluster of Painswick, Bisley and Cranham, and leave Trinity where it belongs, within the boundaries of the town of Stroud.
