Comment text:

I note that this review takes no account of the recent Parliamentary Boundary Review which split a significant part of Gloucestershire into the North Cotswold and South Cotswold Constituencies. This means that the Fairford and Lechlade on Thames Division will be made up of the Wards of Lechlade, Kempsford & Fairford South together with Fairford North from the South Cotswold Constituency, an area containing most of the population in the proposed Division and half of the comparatively lightly populated area of the Coln Valley Ward, a Ward which lies entirely in the North Cotswold Constituency.

I believe that this lack of alignment between the Constituency and Division boundaries will be confusing to residents, particularly should a General Election coincide with or be close to a Local Government (in particular County) election.

Consideration should be given to including all of the Coln Valley Ward in the same Division, all of which would then be in the North Cotswold Constituency.
