I don't see the point in reducing from 90 to 85 councillors, I thought the original proposal was to drastically reduce the number. Local elections in Liverpool have a huge democratic deficit, in that around 75% of the electorate don't bother voting, so you are left with councillors being elected with what seem huge majorities, yet with less than 20% of the eligible votes. I would prefer to increase the size of wards, maybe going from 30 wards to around 20, but with maybe 4 councillors in each, elected by proportional representation
