Related subject: Revised boundary proposals for Oxshott

I completely reject the splitting of Oxshott into North and South. We are one village and want one councillor to represent us (albeit part of the larger Cobham or Esher). There are only around 2,000 houses in Oxshott so I can't see including the whole rather than half makes much difference to a councillor. The revised split is just as bad as the initial split - it now recognises the 'Crown Estate' (North) and 'rest of Oxshott' (South). That is just divisive. Pitting one part of the village against the other. Issues affecting the 'North' equally affect the 'South' - generally traffic, flooding, potholes, heavy goods vehicles, use of the High Street and Centre. Dividing us makes the village into a non-place. No councillor will represent us fully. We'll just be an add on to their larger town. We'll be forgotten. Please leave Oxshott as a single village and don't try to split us up - how would Esher or Cobham residents feel if they were split into a north and south district? I can answer that - not represented at all. Please come up with a solution that keeps Oxshott whole and represented by one councillor.
