Your latest proposal still splits Oxshott in two and I think you are over complicating the issue. Looking at the map the most obvious solution is to have divisions: (1) Esher & Claygate and (2) Cobham & Oxshott. The natural boundary between the two is the A3 running east-west. The other natural dividing line to the east is the A243 up to Malden Rushett.

This avoids splitting Oxshott, the High Street issues and the Village Centre (comprising the Doctor surgery and social facilities) is right on the boundary line.
