Currently there are:

- 63 councillors
- 61 divisions
- 59 single-councillor divisions and 2 two-councillor divisions

81 comments from residents and organisations

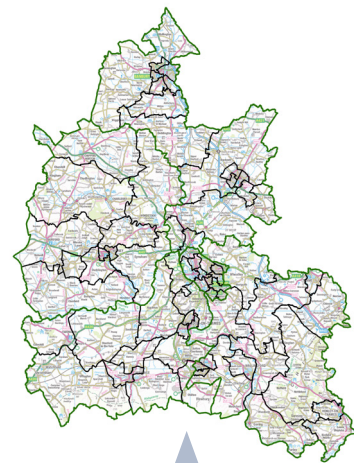


We aim to make sure Oxfordshire councillors represent a similar number of electors



From elections in 2025:

- 69 councillors
- 69 divisions
- 1 councillor per division



Currently there are:

- 21 divisions that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- 2 divisions that are more than 30% away from the average

Oxfordshire will move towards:

- 3 divisions being more than 10% away from the average number of electors per division
- Each councillor representing an average of 8,449 electors
