Dear Sir/Madam

I write as Chairman of the Barnes Residents Association. A recent discussion at a RA meeting was universal in agreeing that Humbledon does not belong in a St Chad's Ward.

The Association therefore objects to these proposals and asks the Commission to return to the previous proposal for a Tunstall and Humbledon Ward and a Barnes and Thornhill Ward, in which the boundary does not run through the centre of the park.

Separately, as a recent resident of Humbledon, I also object on a personal level to being included in a St Chad's Ward because this does not reflect any sense of community. People in my area do not use facilities in East Herrington for the simple fact it is miles away. We have local service provision - including schools - in the Barnes and Tunstall areas. There is no logic to the proposals for St Chad's.
