Good morning

My husband and I live at White Thorn, which is in what has always been the Bollington end of Dumbah Lane. We have recently been advised via our local residents' association (Dumbah Association) that the parish boundaries around Dumbah Lane are up for discussion and that we are no longer going to be part of Bollington and may be moved into Macclesfield ward. Personally we have always been perfectly happy being part of Bollington, although it does cause some confusion as we invariably have to explain that we are not on the Bollington side of the Silk Road.

We have also been made aware that there may be an option for us to move from the Bollington parish to the Prestbury parish. We believe this would made far more sense.

Although technically living in Bollington, when we 'moved North' 25 years ago knowing no-one in the area, our lives have mainly been based in Prestbury. We frequented the local bars and restaurants, we went to baby and toddler groups in the village, our children were christened at St Peter's church and were in the catchment area for Prestbury Primary School. We have been involved over the years with Prestbury Tennis Club, the junior cricket side, and my husband and son have been members at Prestbury Golf Club for many years. We still socialise in Prestbury, my mother has now moved into the village and we regularly eat out in Coast, Bacchus or The Bridge.
