The ward covers a huge area and has three councillors allotted.

The area east of the Crewe to Manchester is basically the old Crewe & Nantwich Borough Council Waldron ward and is experiencing significant amounts of new build housing north of Sydney Road. I query the 2030 predicted residents figures because of these developments and future "fill in" schemes that will follow.

The sub area of this south of the A534 is 100% employment with no residents other than students living in a hall of resident. Because of the way the Medical School operates these are mostly foreign visitors so will not be voters

There is little adult community contact across the Manchester railway other than sharing a not very good bus route and an increasing traffic problem on Sydney Road/Remer Street. Those living in the Ludlow Avenue/Stanhope Avenue enclave may have no contact at all with west of the Manchester railway - not even passing through it. Although the Sir William High School catchment area includes east of the railway many families send their children to other schools, especially in Sandbach.

Having three councillors supposedly represent the whole area is illogical and does not work. It would make more sense for the old Waldron ward to be taken out of East and allocated one of the three councillors

Cheshire Police manage their local policing using ward boundaries which makes the problem even worse.
