The Charity Fund set up in 1951 varied 1959 new scheme sealed July 1997 by the sale of a recreation building donated to Corringham & Fobbing by Canadian Troops as they left for Normandy. We give donations to clubs and sheltered housing complexes to support their social activities. As Homesteads, Stanford, Corringham and Fobbing have merged we donate to complexes where ex residents of C&F now reside in Stanford. Covid badly affected social activities and clubs have closed. It's increasingly difficult to sustain those still carrying on. It's important to not lose the cohesion that has grown up. The proposal to delete the ward names Homestead, Stanford West, and Stanford East and Corringham Town will be detrimental to the established comfortable understanding residents have of their place in the area. If folk feel they live in Corringham through being in Stanford East and Corringham Town ward they can readily feel they do. Much of Stanford East is within a short walking distance of the Corringham Town Centre, which is withering, and we need to support it's status by keeping it's name in the forefront of all our peoples political lives.
