I wish to strongly protest at the proposal to abolish the Freshney Ward here in Grimsby. My husband and I have lived in the Freshney Ward since its existence, some 55 years and take an active part in our community. We have many organisations within our ward one of which is "Freshney Forward" a long standing, enabling community group that helps others with issues and events if needed. We have been going for over 17 years, we are on good working relations with our local PCSOs, Ward Councillors. Great Coates Parish Council, Wood Park community group and our local Churches.

The four areas of the Freshney Ward are Wybers Wood, Aylesby Park, Willows Est and Great Coates all of which work closely together and are within a few minutes walking distance. For the third time, this Christmas we are putting on a Nativity play, it gets bigger every year with over 120 primary school children from the three local schools taking part, along with live animals Donkey Sheep and Goats. We are hopeful for over three hundred residents to attend this year in our Community Garden. Years of working together helping with quiz nights, fish and chip nights Tea and Coffee mornings, Children's fun days, Summer and Christmas fairs, Breakfast clubs to name but a few events.
