I am a happy resident of Wybers/ Aylesby Park and have been for 16yrs. I am utterly opposed to the proposed changes to the boundaries for several reasons- 1. We have a strong local community, strong sense of pride in our area and identify with our neighbours within our borough. Changing the boundaries will have a huge detrimental impact on our sense of community and local identity. There is no reason to take this away from us on what seems to be a politically motivated whim!

2. We have just voted in independent councillors who represent us and our community brilliantly. They were recently voted in - beating Conservative and Labour candidates. Blurring the lines between boroughs will affect the councillors and our democratically elected representing. This is unreasonable, the public have voted for their representatives in their communities. You should not be allowed to start messing with the communities and thus risk affecting the councillors chosen by the people in these communities.

3. I am very concerned about the affects on facilities and infrastructure. The normal congestion in specific hot spots is bad enough. Recent traffic was horrendous - you caused gridlock due to poorly planned roadworks. You failed to stager and plan the roadworks, therefore multiple temporary lights were in place at the same time caused multiple jams and multiple points of delays/ congestion on jouneys. Our roads cannot support increased traffic as it is.

4. The affects on facilities across the wards, losing facilities, the affects on transport, changes affecting peoples roytines. There are teenagers in my family who both use the bus routes for work and college. Changes to the buses will affect them.

5. Also my parents who are elderly and rely on the local facilities and buses. They do not cope with change well as they are elderly and not confident or able to cope with changes. They don't have mobile phones let alone smart phones. If you make changes to geography, local facilities or buses they will not be familiar with them and will lose their confidence in using them. Changes will stop them from doing shopping or going out

in the area and using facilities or doing daily activities that have become commonplace. There is somebody in the family with dementia, he CANNOT cope with changing anything in his routine, geography or that is familiar. If you make changes you will immediately end his ability to go out, use local facilities, go on the bus or to the shops etc.

I 100% object to changing the boundaries!
