Related subject: Bridlington

At present the Bridlington boundaries do not seem to reflect the communities as a whole. Each ward seems to include a chunk of Bridlington which is urban as well as a section of the rural area around the town. The needs and views of people within the urban town and the rural villages surrounding it are very different. As such I believe it would be beneficial for these areas to be remapped for example to provide new wards of Bridlington North, Bridlington South and Bridlington Rural. While the town is split onto two main areas this would allow the rural villages of Sewerby, Marton, Bampton, Flamborough, Boynton and Grindale to be brought together as these areas have much more in common with each other than they do with the town centre itself. This would allow the numbers within each ward to be fairly balanced as well.
