As a resident of Peirce Avenue that regularly uses Olton local amenities and transport links I feel that the road acts well as both a boundary as it stands and also a conduit to travel between the the Solihull areas of Olton and Lyndon at one end and the Birmingham areas of Acocks Green and South Yardley the other. A proposed move of this boundary may appear for suitable on a map but in practice the flow between the wards is currently achieved via the existing boundary line.

I also feel the the historic significance of this boundary should be retained as per the information provided by maps dating back from the 1800's to the second world war when the boundary between the two villages remained and this avenue existed as a through route to the neighboring areas. With regard to the existing living arrangements in this area there is a strong community in both wards which can be retained, I do not feel that there is any real benefit to moving this boundary.
